


FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The NPhA Foundation has averaged \$35,016 in awarded scholarships in the last 3 years, including awarding a record \$38,850 in 2021. The monetary awards come from 22 endowed scholarships and book awards ranging from \$200-\$1000 dollars. The endowed scholarships are a mix of individual and corporate donors, with the Rite-Aid corporation (a Legacy donor) endowing the 1st ever foundation scholarship, and AmerisourceBergen Foundation endowing the most recent scholarship in 2021.

instruments. This
