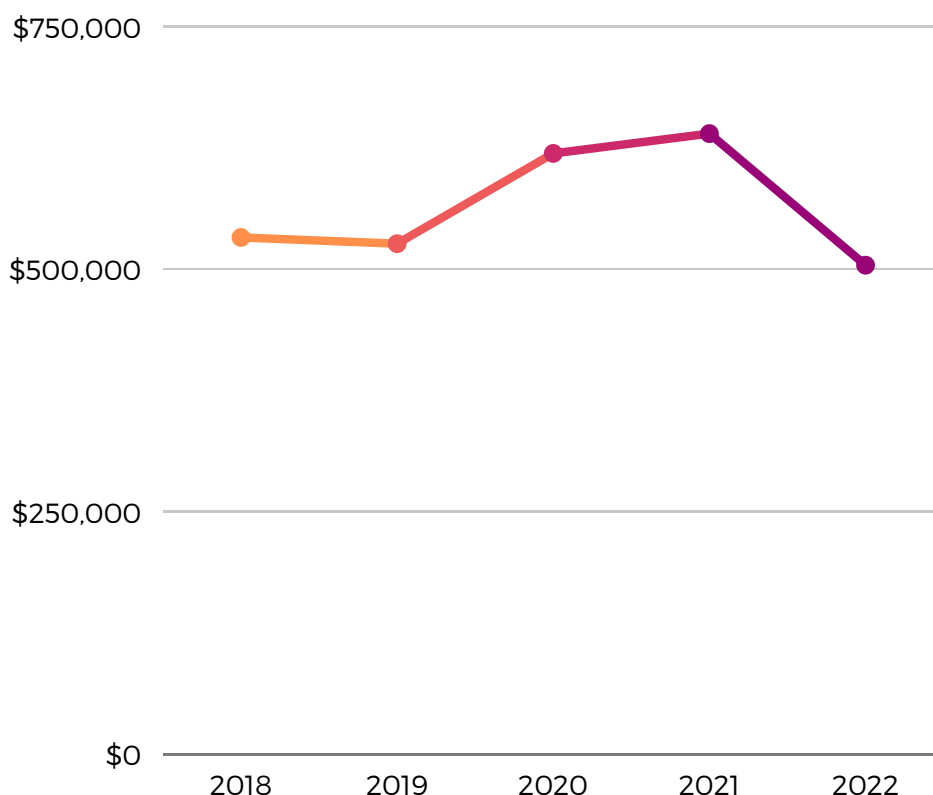
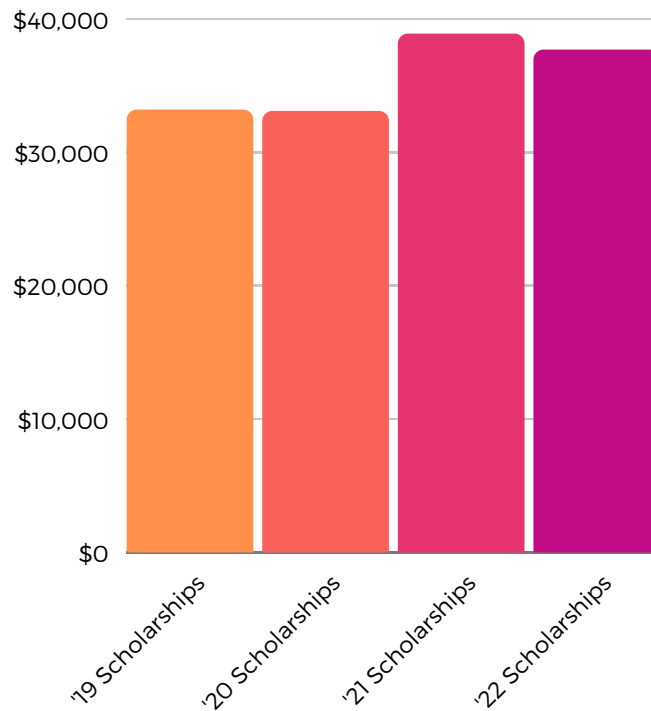

## FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

The NPhA Foundation has averaged \$35,016 in awarded scholarships in the last 3 years, including awarding \$37,650 in 2022. The monetary awards come from 22 endowed scholarships and book awards ranging from \$200-\$1000 dollars. The endowed scholarships are a mix of individual and corporate donors, with the Rite-Aid corporation (a Legacy donor) endowing the 1st ever foundation scholarship, and AmerisourceBergen Foundation endowing the most recent scholarship in 2021.



The NPhA Foundation Endowment currently stands at \$503,939 as of December 1st, 2022. This figure is post-scholarship awards. The endowment is managed by Truist Trust Services and has an allocation of 35% equities and 65% fixed-income instruments. This allocation is reviewed on a regular basis by the Board of Trustees.
